Driver James Lambert hit the root of a tree, causing him to swerve, lose control of his vehicle, and crack into a hitching post.

1896

FIRST SPEEDING FINE

Given to Walter Arnold for speeding 8MPH in a 2MPH zone.



1904

PAPER TRAFFIC TICKET

Harry Myers in Dayton, OH driving 12MPH, issued a \$10 fine.



1896

FIRST TRAFFIC FATALITY

Pedestrian Bridget Driscoll was struck by a car.

1899

SPEEDING ARREST

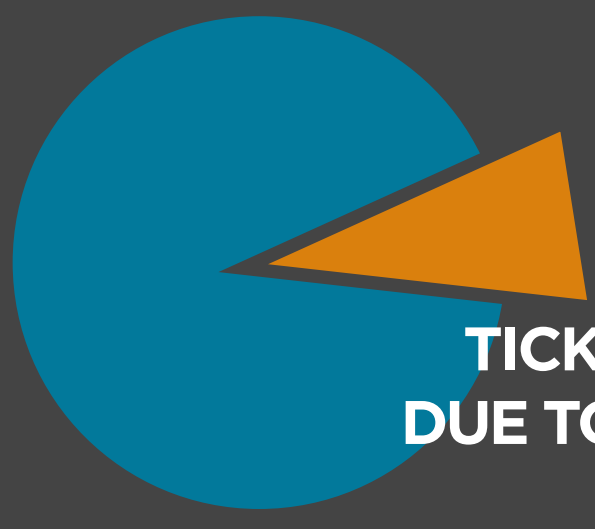
NYC cab driver, Jacob German, was arrested for reaching 12MPH on Lexington Ave.
