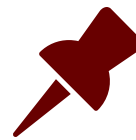

### Training for High-Risk Scenarios



Plan for HazMat scenarios in schools, manufacturing plants, factories, high rises, office buildings



Use Points of Interest (POIs) to draw attention to key details, such as exits, stairwells, elevators, or hazardous materials

### Post-Incident Review



Use OSCR360 as a visual timeline



Discuss each stage of the department's response



Review agency response & where an approach could be improved
