

Your Reunification Plan Checklist



#1

Agreement between school and reunification site

Make arrangements & sign an agreement with an off-site location to use for reunification during an emergency.

#2

Determine roles & responsibilities

Predetermine & assign your staff to designated roles.

#3

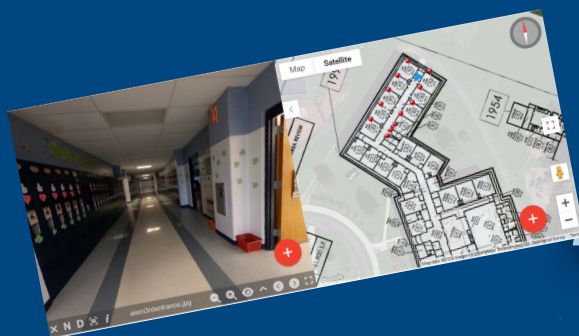
Mark key locations

Predetermine areas for staging command post, parent check-in, waiting areas, parking, first aid, etc.

#4

Communication

Plan for concise communication with first responders, transportation & parents. Pre-planned verbiage for parent communication is helpful



#5

Signage, supplies & equipment

Prepare clear, concise signage to direct individuals as they arrive. Consider any supplies you may need including water & first-aid.

#6

Train & re-train

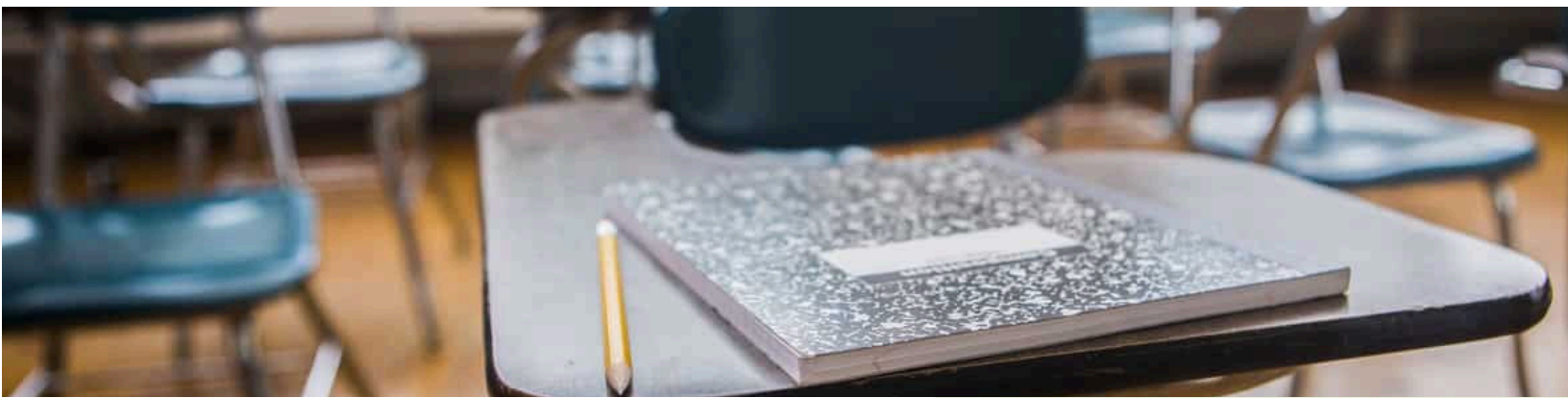
It is difficult to bring your entire staff to the reunification site. Hold regular, virtual trainings on reunification using OSCR360.
